# 1. <u>IW 07/23 #10 – IW Declaratory Ruling – Vegetation Management – 365</u> <u>Woodford Avenue – Anthony Silva, Agent – Hamlin Water's Edge</u> <u>Condominiums.</u>

The applicant is seeking a declaratory ruling from the Commission to manage vegetation within a shoreline area on Hamlin Pond. The applicant is not seeking to fill any wetlands. No deposition or excavation will occur. Most of the work will necessarily be done by hand, and any power equipment that is needed will be operated from an upland area. The invasive species as well as indigenous shrubs are now taking over the submergent area and the Association wants to manage the resource. This is a declaratory ruling under Section 4.2.a. The material, only vegetation above water level will be removed and replacement will be with native cattail.

<u>A motion was made by:</u> P. Martin to approve IW07/23#10, finding that the activity proposed is in keeping with the 4.2 a regulations and is permitted as a non-regulated use.

# 2. <u>IW 08/23 #11 – IW Declaratory Ruling – Water Main Replacement – 195</u> <u>Woodford Avenue – Aquarion Water Company.</u>

The applicant is seeking a declaratory ruling from the Commission to replace an existing water main. The main runs from the Woodford Avenue well fields, where recent work is wrapping up on the town-wide water softening treatment facility. This project is part of an ongoing maintenance program established by Aquarion Water Company to update its infrastructure.

Section 4.1.e of the regulations list construction and operation of water systems as a by-right use.

The applicant representative, Joseph Perugini, Weston & Sampson, explained the project. He also explained additional erosion and sedimentation control measures that will be used.
